# Status Quo, Ziele, Fazit

In the beginning of the studies, it has been crucial to point out our strong and weak points for knowing what to focus on during this journey for two years. Technical abilities, having stability, nice and warm sound, quick adaptation and reaction, being a good listener can be considered as my strengths as an instrumentalist. In my playing, I would like to develop playing more free, flexible and in a more singing way. I am really passionate about singing, I like the feeling of freedom when I sing. I think that to implement this in my bassoon playing would be a successful tool for me to strengthen my musical identity. That is why, the idea of playing in an opera, to be a part of a big production and embracing a character with your instrument makes me so excited.

During this master studies, I would like to prepare myself for auditions, play in different orchestras and learn more about both operatic and symphonic repertoires. Furthermore, it is significant for me to take part in different chamber music groups especially big ensembles. I was frequently performing with trio, quartet or quintet, but it would be more exciting for me to play in a septet or bigger ensembles.

Decisiveness, communication, punctuality, collaboration, adaptability are some of my professional skills. For having an independent professional life I need to be more self-confident and entrepreneur. For having the most benefits from my studies, it is necessary to set some boundries and prioritize my goals. Since I am living alone, far away from my family, I can focus on my study time. Time management and sticking into a study plan play an essencial role to make the most benefit from my study and have the balance of life. Some difficulties can be mentally and economically. Mornings are the efficient times of the day for me. First focusing on my study time and after I can take time for my family/friends and my mental/psysical health. Taking their support will be also really helpful for the stress management.

Toni-Areal is of a number of opportunities for the students to develop themselves as highly-qualified and sophisticated musicians. Not only focusing in our instrument, but also in many areas, various opportunities are provided for us to keep up with technological developments and to be more active in the music environment. I can focus on discovering and learning how to use better the recording systems, technological tools that we can borrow, benefit from the concert halls open to our use, organizing big ensembles using the opportunity for having many talented students in the school.

# **Goals (start of studies)**

My main goal is to develop myself as a highly-skilled orchestral musician to have opportunity for having a place in a qualified orchestra. For my career and the way that I would like to pursue requires to have opportunity to play in a professional orchestra as much as possible, learn the subleties of being an orchestra musician. For achiving this, my purpose is focusing on orchestral/audition repertoire, going deeper with the details in music to make difference. I believe that my quality of being stable in my playing has a big potential for the auditions. In the beginning of my studies, I concentrate on the audition repertoire pieces such as Mozart Bassoon Concerto K191, Saint Saents Sonata in G major Op. 168, Weber Bassoon Concerto, Jolivet Concerto and orchestral excerpts.

After learning the audition repertoire with the bassoon, in the middle of my studies, I would like to give more significance for the contrabassoon playing. Since I discovered that I have a big potential and interest in the sound and character of the instrument. From my point of view, this potential is really worth to invest in, since getting deeper in both instruments will give me more chance to make difference in the auditions. For this reason, I will prepare Deutchmann Sonata for Contrabassoon, Mozart Bassoon Concerto 2. Movement and excerpts.

Additionally, my interest is to play in bigger chamber music ensembles to prepare for orchestra life by concentrating on the subtleties of making music together and to discover the different colours and characters in my playing. The current repertoire will be Mozart Serenade No. 10 for winds in B-flat major. K. 361/370a and Beethoven Septet in E-flat major for clarinet, horn, bassoon, violin, viola, cello, and double bass, Op. 20. When I consider my future, as I mentioned before, I am enthusiastic about spending my life playing in a good quality orchestra. I would like to be more active in the music environment, invited from the other orchestras as a guest.

In addition, after having my stable position, I also would like to phase into teaching, I want to pass on my experiences to future generations and touch their lives. The link between singing and bassoon playing has been always attracted my attention. My purpose is to enter to this world and discover more things in common and I would like to create teaching methods combining them. To achieve these goals, first of all I need a mental training for preparing the auditions. Sometimes I am having struggle with my way of thinking, for that Zhdk offers audition training courses by Mr. Horst Hildebrandt. This will help me to know how to control my thought and make me more focused. To enhance my playing for the auditions, I will take orchestra excerpts lessons from the experienced players from Opernhaus. Lastly, I will take singing lessons to develop my playing in a singing way and to explore more the bridge between singing and bassoon playing for my future teaching methods.

# **Conclusion (end of studies)**

Considering my starting point and the objectives I set at the beginning of my studies, I am pleased to affirm that over the course of these two and a half years, I have successfully achieved my goals. In addition to refining my technical abilities and sound quality, a significant aim was to imbue my playing with a more singing quality. Following singing lessons and observations, I'm gratified to observe a clear improvement in my performances. Throughout my studies, my primary focus was on enhancing my orchestral and audition repertoire to realize my main goal of securing a permanent position in a highly regarded orchestra. Therefore, I systematically pursued the necessary steps to achieve this purpose. My engagement at the Opernhaus, coupled with lessons from solo bassoonists and the constructive feedback I received, played a pivotal role in enhancing my skills and contributing significantly to my improvement along this journey.

In the mid-term, a successful audition led to a three-week contract with the Tampere Philharmonie Orchestra in Finland. Subsequent auditions resulted in a temporary contract as a second bassoon and contrabassoonist with Musikkollegium Winterthur for the 22/23 season. These experiences significantly contributed to my development as a highly-skilled orchestral musician. Alongside these orchestral engagements, I participated in chamber music groups, performed in larger ensembles, and presented pieces like Mozart's Serenade No. 10 for winds in B-flat major, K. 361/370a, and Beethoven's Septet in E-flat major, Op. 20.

Recognizing the significant potential of the contrabassoon, particularly given the scarcity of players at a high level, I dedicated effort to improving my contrabassoon playing. This effort opened doors to perform with notable orchestras such as MusicAEterna and Luzerner Sinfonieorchester, providing opportunities to collaborate with conductors Theodor Currentzis and Michael Sanderling. Positive feedback from respected musicians about my contrabassoon playing and second bassoon skills prompted me to focus my audition efforts in that direction, yielding successful results and constructive feedback.

As I conclude my studies, I am pleased to announce that I have secured a permanent position as co-principal bassoon and contrabassoonist with Musikkollegium Winterthur. My journey at ZHdK not only enriched me musically but also personally. I acquired valuable skills, becoming more enterprising, organized, and independent. Each opportunity at ZHdK has deepened my understanding of my musical and social identity. I am profoundly grateful to my teacher, Giorgio Mandolesi, for guiding me on this path, and to all the teachers at ZHdK who have made significant contributions to my life. Moving forward, I intend to continue my career with an enhanced artistic vision, undertaking additional projects alongside maintaining a stable position.

BASSOON AND CONTRABASSOON


Starting her musical career singing in a choir, Sevgi Varol was accepted to Hacettepe University State Conservatory where she began to study bassoon with Gulnur Kurt in 2007. From 2010, she started taking part in several youth orchestras including Dogus Youth Symphony Orchestra, Ankara Youth Symphony Orchestra, Hacettepe Youth Symphony Orchestra, Bilkent Youth Symphony Orchestra, Turkish-German-French Youth Symphony Orchestra. After completing high school, in 2014 Varol has enrolled in the Bilkent University Faculty of Music and Performing Arts with a high scholarship to continue her bassoon studies with Ozan Evruk. While studying, she was selected as a soloist and has performed Mozart Bassoon Concerto with Bilkent Youth Symphony Orchestra. Furthermore, chosen among the successful students from the faculty, Sevgi Varol has participated in the Bilkent's 30th Anniversary Festival Concert by performing Vivaldi Bassoon Concerto in B-Flat Major with a string ensemble. In 2018, she has completed her bachelor degree in Bilkent University and graduated as the highest ranked graduate of the year. Between 2018-2021 Varol has pursued her first Master's Degree in Music Performance with Matthias Racz in Zurich University of Arts ZHdK in Zurich, Switzerland.

She won the first prize in King's Peak International Music Competition 2021 and after a selection process, has participated in Moritzburg Festival Academy 2021 which has provided the young musicians alongside orchestral work to perform in different chamber music ensembles coaching by well-known musicians such as Albrecht Mayer. In September 2021, with Motus Ensemble which consist of a woodwind quintet, she gave a chamber music recital being a part of Braunwald 85. Musikwoche.





# 8. INFORMATION ON THE NATIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM

### Structure and Degree System

The basic structure of the Turkish National Education System consists of stages of noncompulsory pre-school education; compulsory primary (elementary and middle school) and secondary (high school) education; and higher education. Primary education begins at the age of 5.5 (66 months), lasts eight years and comprises elementary and middle school education, four years each. Secondary education is also four years and divided into two categories as eight years and comprises elementary and middle school education, four years each. Secondary education is also four years and divided into two categories as "General High School Education". The entry into these categories is through composite scores obtained from a central school Education is an "Vocational and Technical High School Education". from a centralized exam for secondary schools.

Higher education system in Turkey is managed by the Council of Higher Education (CoHE, Yükseköğretim Kurulu-YÖK) which is an autonomous public body responsible for the planning, coordination, governance and supervision of higher education within the provisions set forth in the Constitution of the Turkish Republic and the Higher Education Law. Both state and non-profit foundation universities are founded by law and subjected to the Higher Education Law and to the regulations enacted in accordance with it.

Higher education in Turkey comprises all post secondary higher education programmes, consisting of short, first, second, and third cycle degrees in terms of the terminology of the Bologna Process. The structure of Turkish higher education degrees is based on a two-tier system, except for dentistry, pharmacy, medicine and veterinary medicine programmes which have a one-tier system. The duration of these one-tier programmes is five years (300 ECTS) pharmacy, medicine which lasts six years (360 ECTS). The qualifications in these one-tier programmes are equivalent to the first cycle (bachelor's) plus second except for medicine which lasts six years (360 ECTS). The qualifications in these one-tier programmes are equivalent to the first cycle (bachelor's)-(bisans derecesi) cycle (master's) degree. Undergraduate level of study consists of short cycle (associate's)-(önlisans derecesi) and first cycle (bachelor's)-(bisans derecesi) degrees which are awarded after successful completion of full-time two-year (120 ECTS) and four-year (240 ECTS) study programmes, respectively.

Graduate level of study consists of second cycle (master's)-(yūksek lisans derecesi) and third cycle (doctorate)-(doktora derecesi) degree programmes. Second cycle is divided into two sub-types named as master without thesis and master with thesis. Master programmes without thesis require 60 to 90 ECTS credits and consist of courses and a semester project. 60 ECTS non-thesis master programmes are exceptional, and exist in a few disciplines. The master programmes with a thesis require 90 to 120 ECTS credits, which consists of courses, a seminar, and a thesis. Third cycle (doctorate) degree programmes are completed having earned a minimum of 180 ECTS credits, which consists of completion of courses, passing a proficiency examination and a doctoral thesis. Specialization in medicine, accepted as equivalent to third cycle programmes are carried out within the faculties of medicine, university hospitals and the training hospitals operated by the Ministry of Health.

Universities consist of graduate schools (Institutes) offering second cycle (master's) and third cycle (doctorate) degree programmes, faculties offering first cycle (bachelor's degree) programmes, four-year higher schools offering first cycle (bachelor's) degree programmes with a vocational emphasis and two-year vocational schools offering short cycle (associate's) degree programmes of a strictly vocational nature.

Since 2003, first cycle degree holders may apply directly to third cycle (doctorate) programmes if their performance at the first cycle degree level is exceptionally high and their national central Graduate Education Entrance Examination (ALES) score is also high and their application is approved. For these students, theoretical part of the programmes requires additional courses of 60 ECTS credits

Admission of national students to short and first cycle degree programmes is centralized and based on a nationwide one/two-stage examination(s) conducted by an autonomous public body (Assessment, Selection and Placement Centre-OSYM). Candidates gain access to institutions of higher education based on their composite scores consisting of the scores on the selection examination and their high school grade point averages. Admission to graduate programmes is directly conducted by the higher education institutions (HEIs) within the frameworks of the publicly available national and institutional regulations. Admission of foreign students to programmes at all levels of higher education can be done by direct applications of candidates to HEIs based on publicly available national and institutional regulations.


The Turkish National Qualifications Framework for Higher Education (TYYC): The National Qualifications Framework for Higher Education in Turkey (TYYC) developed with reference to the QF for European Higher Education Area and the EQF for lifelong learning was adopted by the CoHE in 2010. The framework has been developed as a part of a single national qualifications framework, which would eventually consists of 8 level national framework covering all levels of educations on completion of the ongoing work at the national level, in which the higher education levels lie on levels between 5 to 8. The levels of the TYYC with reference to the European overarching qualifications frameworks as well as that to ECTS credits and student workload are shown
