
Untitled: Chessboard, 2024

The Exact Calculation of Love

[x = Love]

A	x	→	Angle	+	Light
1st	x	→	Sequence	+	Position
1cm	x	→	Trace	+	Temperature
A perfect	x	→	Duration	+	Friction

Boundary conditions and solution

The calculation of each summand must be formally defined in zero gravity.

In a zero-gravity environment, summands are isolated from external influences.

Despite external influences, every x remains functional but elusive, which is a factor in deviant calculations.

Summations, and summations of variables create repetitive layers of $\boldsymbol{x}.$

The value of "exact x" only occurs during the communication process of layers.

The communication process produces and reproduces results in real numbers (both rational and irrational).

However, not all results are generally true.



STATEMENT

May, 2024

None of my works should be larger than me. This is how I recognize things surrounding me in the first place and pick them up. They become my material. What I choose is what I am limited to recognizing at that moment.

But more than that, I think this attitude comes from being born into an immigrant Thai family and growing up in Zurich. To begin with what I already have, like every found object that I work with. To work with what is left for me in the end, what belongs to me in the end.

Many times, my work looks like a readymade, some of my friends have said. This look didn't come about on its own. Of course, it could be said that today we all have a bit of Duchamp. Or a bit of Warhol. But in my case, as a food scientist specializing in chocolate, the reproduction process happens apparently in front of me every time I work in the factory.

My interests span a wide range, from numbers and calculations to order, systems, predictions, and repetitions. Themes of immigration, home, hope, and the concept of the readymade also permeate my work. While I do not confine myself to any specific artistic practice, I often draw upon my background as a painter, approaching my work with a focus on intuition and revelation rather than invention and revolution.
