Artist Statement

My practice was originally rooted in photography but has since widened to include language (written and spoken), installation, and video.

My work often addresses gender questions, mental health and identity. These themes are interlocked and separate, and sometimes even thriving on one another. I approach these subjects through a mix of personal experience and a lot of research.

I work with the words I loathe, the memories that haunt me, the thoughts that pester me and in opposition to a gaze that's on me. A lot of my pieces give me the chance to disengage and examine the structures that are forced upon me, either by society, by myself, or by my surroundings, willingly - and unwillingly.

The series of images are private thoughts visualized in private spaces. Some of them occur just once, while others reoccur.























highspeed intimacy, 2018
