







Two in a Million, 2021 video (9:15)

While playfully acting upon the notion of competition in the art bubble, Two in a Million uses the framework of a beauty pageant application to make a stylized and oversaturated portrait of the themselves.

Through a rosy mix of biographical facts and self-stereotyped fictions the artists share their experiences on family pressure and influence, economic migration, integration, loneliness, vanity and the art scene.

The performers get hired by an art institution to take care of the guests and create a pleasant atmosphere during an opening. The performers are dressed in hostess uniforms like seen on grid girls, box pit girls, female animators and so on. They are constantly asked to pose, twirl, dance and smile for photos for the pleasure of the exhibition's visitors.

The work draws attention to the similar roles played by entertainers at social gatherings and artists at openings. Furthermore it is pointing at the topic of male dominance and male-gaze in the art field.



The Flowers, 2020 vintage glass items, looped audio

The installation is made out of more than 100 inherited and/or thrifted glassware items. In the work the outdated symbols of working class luxury are stripped of their factual value and primary purpose. By using the sentimental glassware as raw material for sculpture-making, they reach their absolute decorativeness in a form of a flower.

Arranged into an installation the work aims to evoke a moment of unclouded joy and lightness when walking through the fragile meadow accompanied by soothing sound.

Amazed by the beauty and grace of The Flowers the girls touch and play with the flowers fearlessly. With the help of magical whistling the Enchantress makes the girls do whatever she wants until they fall into a state of euphoria.
