MEMENTO MORI

The images in this series, *Memento Mori* (Latin: 'Remember you will die'), attempt to visualise the experience of the death of consciousness in the human process of dying. They constitute my own poetic vision of death and dying, which I imagine as a psychedelic experience filled with transcendent light and colour visions. The works were born from a desire to understand the psychical process of dying in the human organism and in doing so to confront the fear and taboo surrounding this process that is so dominant in Western culture.

The works will be displayed as wall mounted light-boxes in a silent, darkened room – creating a space of sombre reverence, so as to be viewed in a respectful manner, whilst also infusing the room with their internal glow and allowing the viewer to meditate on their purpose.
