STATEMENT

I focus on gardening and the culture and life of the valleys of my birthplace, Ticino.

Learning from communities that make do with what is in their immediate surroundings, I source materials such as jute, wool and the remnants of my territory.

My method emerges from ways of questioning, interrogating, and negotiating the connection I have with the environment I enter. I take this knowledge as a starting point for thinking about identity and my action (or non-action) in the relationships I observe in my surroundings.

This requires an approach based and cultivated on the environment itself, on a constant oscillation between doubts and responses based on a sensitive understanding that allows me to be part of the ecosystem I am interacting with.

What resources do we decide to consume and how does the consumption change our environment?

By what means and by whom or what are we shaped as 'individuals', which relationships do we cultivate and which do we let go of?

These relationships require indefiniteness and care, for we are as much a part of our ecosystem as our ecosystem is a part of ourselves.
