


























One - Song -Repetition




2022 performance 3 interventions

Imagining an atmosphere where the sound gets collapsed, overlaid, and amplified, guided me to create a performance based on ASMR. Combining this act with music, it is important to take into account the general basis of sound waves and various types of influence on the body in terms of frequency and its perception at the physical level. Thus, the creation of the performance was inspired by the combination of commonality and difference.



The project was carried out in collaboration with Yuchen Zhang, a professional guitarist. We wanted to see how a performer's emotions of the musical piece and its sound are transformed through the prism of the artist's perception and are realized in the form of an abstract painting. The performative component, inherent only to this medium, gives more opportunity to follow the process and deeply understand emotional content.
