
Artist Statement

Through my artistic practice, I investigate fields of identity politics, with an aim to question and challenge conventional perceptions of social dynamics.

My work focuses on the nuances and dynamics of power, privilege, and marginalization, exploring their interplay in our social structures. By these I examine the layers of our society to expose the underlying structures that perpetuate discrimination. I represent these topics collaboratively through photography, video, installation and sculpture. This spatial approach allows me to reflect on the complex nature of identity, presenting plurality of narratives.

Iluminating the invisible threads that connect our past to the present I question the preconceived notions and societal constructs that surround formation of identity politics. By this I strive to create a platform for introspection, empathy, and understanding of diverse communities.

These interactions are a crucial part of my artistic process which enables me to communicate visual narratives that resonate on a personal and universal level. My artistic journey is an ongoing exploration, fueled by inspection of identity politics system formation. Questioning who this system represents and what kind of tensions emerge from it.






Production image: Traffic signs/Prism changers, printed text and images on 6 surfaces, 917 x 1398 mm, 698 x 1233mm




Installation view: 3 channel video projection on a rooftop (2.5 x 7.5m)


